### 01 · OVERVIEW

**Columbus Quartermaster LLC** is a veteran-owned, minority-owned commodity sourcing and fulfillment company serving federal, state, and local government buyers. The Company sources commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) products from authorized U.S. manufacturers and small-business distributors and coordinates manufacturer-direct fulfillment to government destinations under FOB Destination terms — a lean operating model that translates to faster lead times and competitive pricing.

The Company is built for response speed and pricing discipline. Single-operator overhead enables aggressive quotes without layered distributor margins. Manufacturer-direct sourcing means lead times limited only by the manufacturer's stock position. An opportunistic, multi-vertical posture means engagement with end-of-fiscal-year procurement surges, emergency requirements, and any commodity lane where lean fulfillment delivers competitive value.

Founded in 2021 and led by Nicholas Barber, a former U.S. Army Ranger, Columbus Quartermaster operates as a commodity sourcing and fulfillment specialist positioned to accept federal purchase orders, BPA call orders, and state and local government contracts under FAR Part 12 and FAR Part 13 simplified acquisition procedures.
